Overview

About the Event

Following the tragic events at Grenfell Tower, fire safety has become a major issue in housing. The Scottish Government recently introduced legislation requiring that all homes have fire and smoke alarms that meet the standard required in new build homes. There are also proposals to introduce sprinklers in all new build social housing, while the Scottish Government is reviewing guidance for building managers of high rise properties.

Why Should you Attend?

You will hear about:

- Changes to the tolerable standard that require upgrades to fire and smoke alarms in all existing homes
- Proposals to require fire suppression systems in all new build housing
- A consultation on the management of high rise buildings, including guidance on resident engagement and communication and good practice in Fire Risk Assessments

There will be speakers from:

- Scottish Government
- Scottish Fire and Rescue Service
- Housing associations who have reviewed their approach to high rise property management and to engaging with residents

This one day event will hear from experts on what the changes mean for social landlords, look at different approaches to meeting the new standards for fire and smoke alarms and hear about good practice in managing buildings and how to engage tenants in fire safety and with the fire service

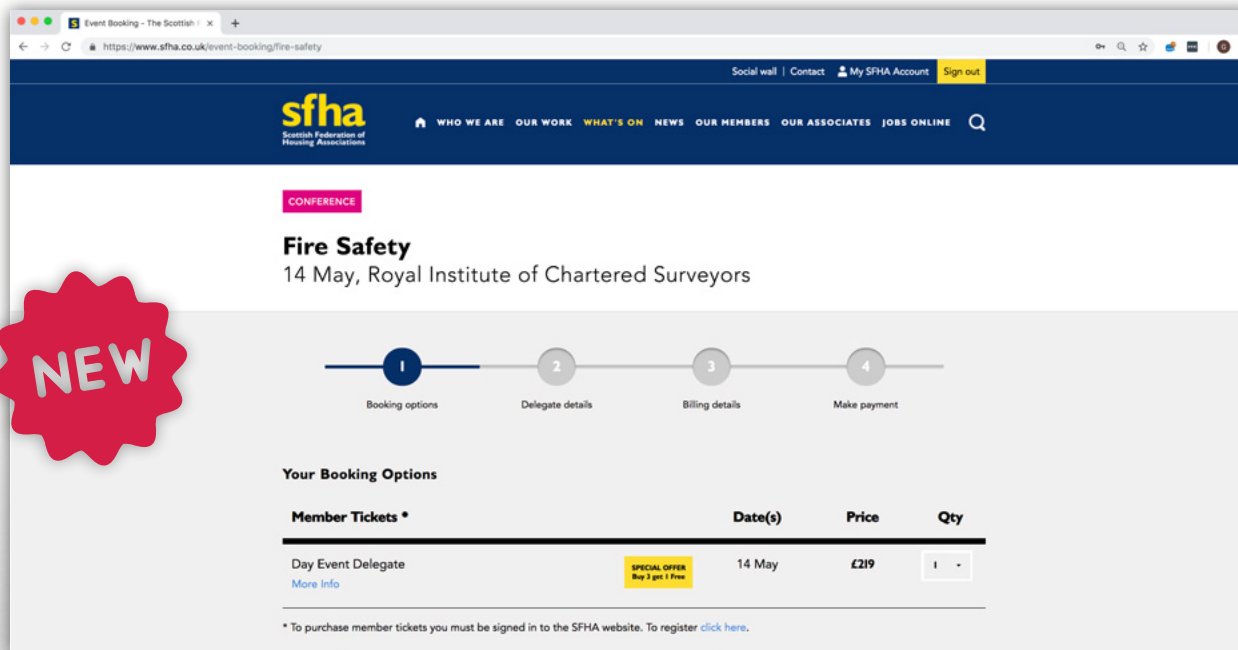
