Key Changes since 18 April 2016

- Public Contracts (Scotland) Regulations 2015,
- Procurement Reform (Scotland) Act 2014,
- ESPS & ESPD Module within PCS,
- Below EU threshold in Scotland £50K & £2M, (EU £181k & £4.55m)
- Wider use of Quick Quotes,
- Community Benefits in procurements,
- Use of Public Contracts Scotland (PCS),
- Regulated & Non-Regulated Procurement

What have we found in the last year?

- Generally a better understanding of the Regs & Reform Act,
- Large increase in HA using QQ and PCS,
- VfM in procurement when done correctly,
- Increase in HA's interest and use in Frameworks inc Pre-tendered,
- Increase in bundling of contracts that limits opportunities for SMEs,
- Pockets of interest in collaboration,
- Increased knowledge of non-regulated process, PCS, ESPD & Quick Quotes,
- Increase in use of Consultants to assist and advise RSL's (not always good assistance or advice),
- Increased use of Bid Writers for suppliers/contractors,
- Continued & wide use of SFHA Procurement Advisor Service.
