Our mission is to change this. In partnership with employers and schools, we deliver an 18-month programme of mentoring and a paid fourweek internship for young people aged 16-18.

PROGRAMME LAUNCH



S5 student and mentor matching and separate preparatory sessions, lead to meeting for the first time at an area-wide launch event

MENTORING



Monthly (60-90 mins) mentor meetings in mentor's workplace or school

PAID INTERNSHIP



A four-week paid internship at mentor's workplace, June- July

MASTERCLASSES



Skills sessions delivered by volunteers, occasionally as part of a workplace visit

ALUMNI NETWORK



Sustained support for young people beyond school when they graduate in S6.

There is the opportunity for our employer partners to deliver and host skills masterclasses, opening your doors to Career Ready students from partner schools, and raising awareness of what your organisation has to offer.

Who we support

Young people who often lack support networks, access to opportunities, and job / career awareness due to their socio/economic background

75% are from a low socio-economic background

61% live in Indices of Multiple Deprivation deciles 1-4

32% have been eligible for Free School Meals

38% have been eligible for Education Maintenance Allowance (EMA)





From February

Employer supporters begin promotion of the Career Ready programme internally. Career Ready can provide help and supporting materials

April - July

Employer supporters confirm mentor names and email addresses to Career Ready

April - Sept

Mentors complete online registration accessed via welcome email from Career Ready. PVG scheme membership obtained

Oct - Nov

Mentor & student meet for the first time at an area Launch Event

October

Mentor & student are matched.

Mentors attend an area Mentor
Briefing session, where they will meet matched student's school coordinator

Nov - Jan

Mentor & student have next meeting in school with parents / carers

Thereafter, monthly mentoring meetings take place
